Sustainability Updates:

Jeri –

Plugging along. Working on reflection statements. Experiencing more comfort level with this part of the process. Benchmarks are easier to work with than GBP piece. Right now the Library's Social and Outreach Team is taking priority. Pat-Med set up a food pantry. (Lisa asked Jeri to post pictures.)

Debbie -

Recently completed the GBP portion and beginning to work on the benchmarks. Different staff members will be taking on different sections. The Green Team narrated

their presentation for the GBP portion and presented it to staff. It will be on the Library website. Green Team will also be presenting to the Leadership Team so they are in the loop on the process.

Claudia -

Family Preparedness Kits were made by staff. Contained first aid information, emergency preparedness information in both English and Spanish, cloth masks, coloring pages. Kits were received well. Received construction funds which will fund LED lighting conversion project.

Janet -

Beginning to pick up work on the benchmarks once again. Meeting with Green Team next week. Will be dividing up work amongst the Team.
