Update On Member Access to PrintReleaf Dashboard



In last months newsletter we announced an update to the paper reporting process for Sustainable Library Certification Program (SLCP) members through our partnership with PrintReleaf to help with reforestation efforts.

On Wednesday, August 2nd, all SLCP members will be receiving a welcome email from PrintReleaf granting them access to their dashboard. Simply follow the prompts outlined in the email to create a password for your account and log in to your library's dashboard. From your dashboard you will be able to see your recent deposits, view and print your library's impact statements, and choose reforestation projects.

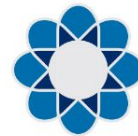

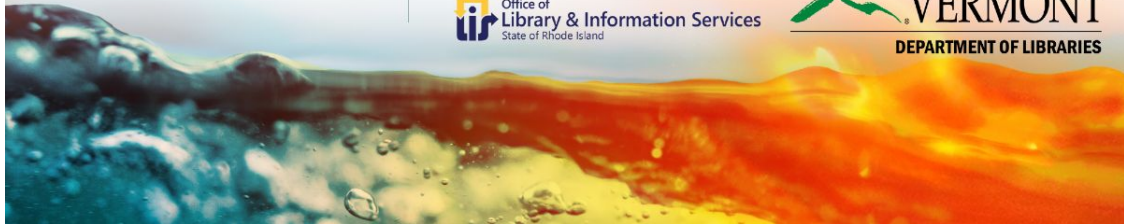
